This prospectus supplement relates to the resale by the holders of Amkor Technology, Inc. 5.75% Convertible Subordinated Notes due 2006 and the shares of common stock, \$0.001 par value per share, issuable upon the conversion of the Convertible Notes.

This prospectus supplement should be read in conjunction with, and may not be delivered or utilized without, the prospectus dated August 27, 2001 and any other amendments or supplements thereto. The terms of the Convertible Notes are set forth in the prospectus.
