All of the stock of Swallow Ltd. is owned by an irrevocable trust created May 10, 1994 of which James J. Kim is the sole beneficiary. The trust was funded by the father of James J. Kim. Turquoise Investments Ltd. and Swallow Ltd. are being dissolved and the trust is being terminated.

2. Includes 49,594,980 shares held by 915 Investments, LP, in which the reporting person is the general partner.
